



Frank Boulevard Pavement Rehabilitation

Project Name: Frank Boulevard Pavement Rehabilitation

Project Description: This project consists of new asphalt roadway, pervious pavement parking lane, curbs, drive aprons, sidewalk, storm sewer, water main, street lighting, traffic signalization and railroad crossing at White Pond Dr., reconfiguration of Thompson Dr./Frank Blvd./Lorena Ave. and the Teeple Dr./White Pond Dr. intersections, and vegetative mounding along W&LE railroad tracks.

In other project related information, the city of Akron is currently assessing alternatives which would provide a smooth transition for traffic flow from N. Pershing Dr. to Frank Blvd. The city of Akron, Engineering Bureau in conjunction with the Ohio Department of Transportation will be discussing various options which will focus on keeping thru traffic on N. Pershing Dr., W. Market St., and Frank Blvd. while not impacting the integrity of the neighborhood. A preferred alternative should be selected in the Fall on 2010.
